SHORT DESCRIPTION

AWARDS: Golden medal Concours mondial Bruxelles, Golden medal Syrah du monde 2021, Golden medal The balkans international wine competition & festival 2021.

Climate:

Dry warm summers. In the winter it can sometimes be very cold with at times a lot of winter snowfall. The nearby mountains regularize the temperatures and bring coolness in the summer and keep the soil warmer in the winter.

Soil:

A total of 17 ha of vineyard formed by a series of hills with a minimum height of 300m. Located in the Vardar Valley. Southern exhibition. Poor sandy soils with limestone in the substrate and rolled boulders in the upper layer.

Vinification:

This estate bottled Syrah wine is marked with a touch of excellence resulting from the double crop reduction, which leads to a partial dehydration of the grapes on the vines, but also from the presence of 8% of Vranec grapes. These steps enable obtaining a phonologically ripe wine. The complexity of this wine comes from the 20-month ageing in new American and French oak barrels.

CHATEAU KAMNIK

The most awarded Macedonian winery. Winners at Decanter World Wine Awards 2013 of the Gold Medal and Regional Trophy for Best Red Wine in Central & Eastern Europe. Founded and first vines planted in 2004, Kamnik had his first harvest in 2008 and it's first awards in 2009. In 2014, the production capacity increased up to 120 000 liters. Authentically Macedonian, the Kamnik winery expresses the greatness of the ancient Macedonian traditions, spirits and soil, in a truly contemporary wine style. Blending past and future, traditions and the sophisticated state-of-the-art approach, nature and science, challenges us to find the most captivating wine tastes. The aims and visions of the winery team are set to keeping the historical and traditional values alive, adapting them to the demands of the modern fine wine market, simultaneously examining the opportunities that the advanced technological applications unfold for us.
